Dear Schubert Chorale Members,

I am happy to announce the exciting **15th Anniversary Summer Season** of the Schubert Chorale, a summer choir for adult, college, and high school singers!

Our anniversary celebration performance will be titled "Fun, Fun, Fun! with Cars, Trains, and Planes." The chorale will open the program with a song that depicts a fast train ride, "Traveling Song," by Mikhail Glinka. We will continue with David Brunner's grandiose setting of John Magee's popular poem "High Flight," Kirby Shaw's Latin groove setting of "Fly Me to the Moon," and David Eddleman's rollicking setting of the famous cable car song "Funiculi, Funicula."

The Women's Choir will present "Route 66" and "The Trolley Song" from *Meet Me in St. Louis*. The Men's Choir will sing The Beach Boys' original harmonizations of automobile favorites "Fun, Fun, Fun" and "I Get Around." The audience will join in the Navy Hymn. The chorale will finish with the Air Force Hymn, "Wells Fargo Wagon" from *The Music Man*, and John Rutter's exciting "The Heavenly Aeroplane." Our rehearsals and performance will be held again at **Sycamore Presbyterian Church**, 11800 Mason Road, Cincinnati, Ohio 45249. The church is in Sycamore Township, approximately two miles north of I-275 and half a mile off I-71 at exit 19.

Rehearsals will take place on Tuesdays, from June 18 through August 13, from 7:00 p.m. to 9:00 p.m. Singers will be required to attend at least 7 of the 9 rehearsals. There will be a vocal placement audition for new singers at the first rehearsal. **The concert** will take place on Sunday, August 18, at 4:00 p.m., with a 2:45 p.m. call. Tickets for the concert will be \$10 for audience members.

In the past, we have invited all members to join us in optional **Schubertiades**, which are occasions to meet other singers in social events such as an affordable dinner before rehearsal, or ice cream afterwards. This year we hope to enjoy the following events:

- Lebanon Mason Monroe Railroad ice cream social and train ride, \$20
- Wright B Flyer Museum in Miamisburg, free
- Cars and Coffee West Chester, free

Our **performance attire** will feature our coastal blue polo shirts as introduced two years ago, with the choir name embroidered on them. All members will be asked to wear khaki or tan pants or skirts, with nice brownish shoes or women's sandals. New members may purchase the polos for \$20, and returning members may wear last year's polos if they are still in excellent condition and if they still fit. Otherwise, returning members may order a new polo if they prefer.

Polos are 60/40 cotton/poly pique, with flat knit collar and cuffs, 4-button placket for women's, 3-button placket for men's, dyed-to-match buttons, and side vents. Women's sizes XL and above tend to run slightly small, so please order accordingly.
