Rehearsals will be held again at Heritage Presbyterian Church, 6546 Mason Montgomery Rd, Mason, OH 45040 (*except for the June 23 rehearsal, which will be held at Lakeview United Church of Christ, 8639 Columbia Road, Maineville, Ohio 45039*). Rehearsals will take place on Tuesdays, from June 16 through August 11, from 7:00 p.m. to 9:00 p.m., with a dress rehearsal on Saturday, August 15, from 10:00 am to 12:00 noon. Singers will be required to attend at least 7 of the 10 rehearsals. There will be a vocal placement audition for new singers at the first rehearsal.

The performance will take place at Heritage Presbyterian Church on Sunday, August 16, at 4:00 p.m., with a 2:45 p.m. call for singers.

Schubertiades are occasions to meet other singers in optional social events such as an affordable dinner before rehearsal, or ice cream afterwards. All members are welcome!

Performance attire this year will be a little more formal than the coastal blue polo shirts we have been wearing for the past four years, so as to align with the grandeur and ceremony of the concert's patriotic theme.

1. We will wear professional concert black attire, including solid black long-sleeved dress shirts or blouses, with solid black dress slacks or long skirts and matching shoes and socks or stockings. Blouses may have $\frac{3}{4}$ -length sleeves. Shirts may have an open collar with a black undershirt, or singers may wear a tie. No short sleeves, t-shirts, polos, open backs, turtlenecks, plunging necklines, or sequins are permitted.
2. Each singer may add a touch of red, white, and/or blue colors as he or she likes, whether with a tie, scarf, pocket square, lapel pin, sash, vest, jewelry, or other such adornment as approved by our uniform chair, Terri Cerimele-Rieger.

Please return your **registration form and check** for the \$75 registration fee by **May 15**, so that we may tally an accurate count for ordering music. There is a \$50 late fee for returning members who register after that date. Contact me if you have extenuating circumstances that would make your decision to commit by the deadline challenging. I look forward to seeing you soon!
